



2022 Assistant Counselor Job Description

Assistant Counselors are the front-line staff for providing a safe, unforgettable, and uniquely Jewish summer experience for campers. Assistant Counselors are responsible for the direct care of campers which includes ensuring camper's good hygiene and health, writing and facilitating bunk and village activities, assisting at Program Areas, performing evening duties in the bunk/village on a rotating schedule, teaching CITs best practices for being staff at CSL, and working in conjunction with all other camp staff to provide a healthy living and learning environment for all. Assistant Counselors report directly to their Unit Head.

Assistant Counselors may be assigned to any of the following villages; Mohawk, Seneca, Onondaga, Cayuga

Counselors must be Lifeguard certified or willing to be trained, previous childcare experience preferred, 18+ years old preferred.

Roles/Responsibilities/Expectations:

- Be responsible for the general health and safety of all campers and staff
- Establish an atmosphere in which campers feel secure, happy, and included
- Supervise campers under their immediate care at all time
- Ensure campers and staff adhere to camp rules
- Act as a positive role model
- Participate in all camp activities and supervisory initiatives
- Cooperate with all other staff regarding matters of rules, safety, and program
- Other duties as assigned by Unit Head, Program Area Leader, and CSL Directors
